Tallahassee, FL – The Innocence Project of Florida announces the installation of Brian Tannebaum as Chair of the Board of Directors. Tannebaum's term began November 9, 2018, and runs for 2 years.

Tannebaum is a graduate of the University of South Florida and Stetson University College of Law.
